No change in NH's high electric costs for another month

The latest stats (http://www.eia.gov/electricitv/monthly/epm_table_grapher.cfm? $\underline{t}=\underline{epmt}$ 5 06 b) from the US Energy Information Association shows NH's electric costs are still 53.5% higher than the national average. That's the same as the previous month. Throughout 2016, NH's average has been between 51.8% and 59.3% higher - with the steepest rates coming during the winter months.


